Previous Minutes – Kim Docherty

Principal Report – Mary Heenan

- o Staffing Update Lots of movement
- o School Play Update same dates but smaller production.
- o EQAO Grade 3 & Grade 6 May 13th & June 3rd
- o Anti-Bullying Update staff and visiting principals have been a big help communication has been key with what is happening and with who. Speaker Chris Gray was a very positive influence on students & staff.
- o Talking about installing sod in the 'mudpit' where the old portable was.
- o Extra-curricular activities (sports) have been targeted to Grade 5 & 6. Parents would like to see Grade 4s included as they are feeling excluded.
- Outside activities are being considered for students. Lorena looked at having basketball hoops installed on the exterior walls, board said that was no longer allowed. Outdoor equipment is needed both inside & outside.

Teachers Report – Tracey Leeson

- o Teachers are looking for assistance with equipment for the gym as well as for outside use
- o Council will require a list of items with monetary amount being asked for (ie. 50 hockey sticks for \$500).
- o Council had spoken about completing a used equipment fundraiser. Will this help with any items being asked for?
- o Lorena & Mary will prepare a list with teachers and the teacher representative will come back with a list and amount at next meeting.

Fundraising Update- Ashley Graham

- o By Sweetness (decorating cookie company)— 10 cookie kit, comes with 8 edible markers. 35% of every kit comes back to the school. \$3100 with free shipping. \$22 for a kit online ordering, shelf stable.
 - Discussion from council members was this is a neat idea, however cookie dough would be more well received then cookie decorating.

- Cookie Dough online ordering will be key. These will be big orders, have stipulations on staying cold and how long we can hold onto them.
 Volunteers will be required. Ashley will research a couple companies and will follow up via email to decide and get started.
- o Other fundraisers ideas: Movies (not feasible), Dance-a-thon yes if possible, would like Jimmy as DJ again (Kim will reach out). Possible May date to be proposed. Follow up at next meeting.

Nutrition Program – Samantha Dennis

- o Went to other schools to see how the nutrition programs are run.

 Classes will receive tickets for a raffle for a pizza day. Cereal will also be a part of a school wide dominos game.
