- **Playground** in the amount of \$43,000 has been paid in full to board.

- o Donations and prizes will be collected from volunteers
- Talks on equity for all students to value all contributions in terms of prizes
- Nature Nancy has reached out expressing interest at \$375/day. Principal will contact regarding spring available dates. Council supports funding this initiative again this year.
- Parent Reaching Out Grant is \$1000 per school to help reach out to parents, often a local author, police official or mental health professional. Grant to be filled out with December 2024 deadline. Easy application, looking for volunteers to take it on.
- Constitution Update in order to align with board policy. Draft for next year being prepared

- A volunteer sign-up sheet will be available shortly
