- Land Acknowledgement (Mary Coulas) We would like to respectfully acknowledge that the land on which we gather is the treaty and traditional territory of the Mississauga First Nations. - Principal Report Rebecca Padgett
 - SILVER BIRCH reading club, read own book or forest of reading book.
 Small write up from books, picture up on TV of kids and then add books to library after that. Involves bigger and smaller kids
 - o New access pass for kindergarten yard door has been completed. Approximately \$4000. Everyone happy that it is now done.
 - o Nursing students nutrition presentation, working with Luisa for nutrition and knowledge and working with gym classes.
 - Ongoing Staff meeting next week, math talks, re-alouds, tier 1 and 2 vocabulary, success criteria, EQUAO dates are in progress. Enrollment projections and staff planning is ongoing. Transition meetings from grade 6 to 7 to Adam Scott. In school conferences, meeting with teachers to follow up on kids, room for growth. Referrals etc.

- Treasurer's Report Alicia Leany (Lauren Fitzsimmons)
 - \$6,000 fundraised so far (Dance-a-Thon, Auction Baskets, Mabels Labels, Dominos)
 - **o** Spent on playground repair, Dance-a- thon, Jimmy Chapman, Nature Nancy and nutrition program.
 - We are planning on spending more than we have brought in but we have more money carried over from last year.
 - **o** \$3000.00 family donation can be used to help pay for Nature Nancy
 - o APPROVAL for paying \$3000.00 to cover Nature Nancy costs.

ACTION – April meeting, talk about next phase of playground, next piece, fundraising, cost ear mark.

- Regional Council Update Lydele Gauci
 - Parent conferences discussed back in November. We have a link that can go out to all parents. Talk on everyday resiliency. Key note speaker Dr.Dafoe, specialist.
 - o Learning to activate five pillars of resiliency in everyday life.
 - o Link under parent conferences on website
 - February meeting big focus was on attendance. Number of kids missing 10 plus school days so far this year. Since Covid, a large decline in attendance.
 - o Brought up the issue of illness and it being a reason for kids being more absent since Covid.
 - o Noticing YES at our school, a decline and in city and province as well. Really raising concerns across the board.
 - o Keen to provide support to parents regarding attendance. And prolonged parents protocol.

- New Business Lauren Fitzsimmons
 - o Parent reaching out is scheduled April 2nd for kids and April 8th evening for parents
 - \$2000.00 received from board and Parent Council approved \$600 likely
 \$2500.00 total cost
 - Asked to support reading club and then books from this initiative would end up in library. MOTION – Samantha Dennis motioned for, seconded by Noni and approved by all.
 - Discussion regarding community calendar or glance at the week new letter for what is going on at school. Parents are reaching out for information regarding what activities etc. are occurring at school as filtering down from children is

not happening. Potential printout or email similar to Adam Scott for information to parents is recommended.

• Board decision regarding boundaries is not well communicated within the school community. Discussion regarding changes and effect on our school, including students, class sizes and teachers/staffing.

ACTION – Send school transfer request information out to parents for their information reminding them of the possibility and process (Rebecca Padgett).
