Kindergarten Registration



If you have a child, or know of anyone who has a child who is eligible to attend either Junior or Senior Kindergarten for September 2019, please come into the school or contact us at 705-745-0722 to register. In addition, you can register online at

www.kprschools.ca.

The following information will assist you with the registration process: Junior Kindergarten students must be 4 as of December 31, 2019. Senior Kindergarten students must be 5 as of December 31, 2019. Proof of age by birth certificate or equivalent and proof of address must be provided. In addition, immunization is required. Accurate enrollment projections are key to getting funding from the Ministry of Education and to the Board's budget process.
