Arrival or Departure



Edmison Heights has a "Safe Arrival Program". This means that we need to hear from you when a student will be late or absent for the day. This enables the attendance to be completed promptly and we know that all of our students are safe. Please

note that you must call in before 8:55 am at 1-844-434-8119 to report for the same day. There are options for reporting in advance or for multiple days. In addition, parents/guardians have the option of reporting online. To register for reporting online, visit studentabsence.kprdsb.ca or use the mobile app, search for SchoolMessenger (one word) on Google Play Store or Apple App Store.

Students leaving early must sign out through the office. Students are reminded that we expect consistency in arrival and departure habits. If a student is a bus student, we expect that most days, that student will be arriving and leaving on the bus. If there is any change to a student departure habit for any given day, a note must be handed in to the classroom teacher.

When picking up students at the end of the day, we ask that you please wait outside. We are trying to keep the school hallways free for the safe dismissal of all our students.



Boomerang Lunch
