Arrival or Departure

Edmison Heights has a "Safe Arrival Program". This means that we need to hear from you when a student will be late or absent for the day. This enables the attendance to be completed promptly and we know that all of our students are safe. Please note that you must call in before 8:55 am at 1-844-434-8119 to report for the same day. There are options for reporting in advance or for multiple days. In addition, parents/guardians have the option

of reporting online. To register for reporting online, visit studentabsence.kprdsb.ca or use the mobile app, search for SchoolMessenger (one word) on Google Play Store or Apple App Store.

Students leaving early must sign out through the office. Students are reminded that we expect consistency in arrival and departure habits. If a student is a bus student, we expect that most days, that student will be arriving and leaving on the bus. If there is any change to a student departure habit for any given day, a note must be handed in to the classroom teacher. When picking up students at the end of the day, we ask that you please wait outside. We are trying to keep the school hallways free for the safe dismissal of all our students.



Please join the thousands of parents who have already registered and are enjoying the convenience of paying ONLINE! It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Follow these step-by-step instructions to begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

Step 1: Register

a) If you have not registered, please go to the *School Cash Online* home page https://kprdsb.schoolcashonline.com/ and select the *"Get Started Today"* option.

b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps

*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.



Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account. The confirmation link will open the *School Cash Online* site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name.
- b) Enter the School Name.
- c) Enter Your Child's First Name, Last Name and Birth Date.
- d) Select Continue.
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in

the Agree box and select Continue.

f) Your child has been added to your account.

Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" and repeat the steps above. 8 children can be added to one parent account. If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.



Student Transportation Services of Central Ontario (STSCO) Winter Newsletter - November 2019

Dear Families, Parents and Guardians:

The winter season will soon be here, and it is very important that everyone using the school busing system is familiar with STSCO's winter weather procedures.

On winter mornings, inclement weather and poor road conditions may lead to the delay or cancellation of school transportation services. On such days, bus delay and cancellation information will be posted on the www.stsco.ca website, our primary means of communicating about busing. Local radio stations and media outlets will also be provided this information to broadcast.

As a parent or guardian, it is recommended that you use the attached "Inclement Weather Days" reference sheet and that you keep it in a prominent place for quick use on inclement weather days.

Also, keep in mind that you should:

- know your child's school bus route number and the name of the company operating it;
- listen to your favourite local radio station for cancellation updates;
- visit the www.stsco.ca website in the morning for delays or cancellations; or
- access the www.stsco.ca website and choose to receive delay and cancellation information by:
 - voluntarily providing your email address for direct email notices from STSCO; or
 - signing on to receive STSCO's Mass Area Cancelation posts on Facebook or Twitter.

Other reminders include:

- If a bus is cancelled in the morning, it will also be cancelled in the afternoon.
- Make sure that your child is at the bus stop 10 minutes prior to the scheduled bus arrival time in the morning. If you meet your child in the afternoon, make sure you are at the stop 10 minutes before bus arrival.
- Review busing procedures with your child so they will know what to do if their bus is late or cancelled.

If you need to confirm your child's route number, you can visit the www.stsco.ca website and click on the "PARENT LOGIN" link and follow the onscreen instructions. You will need your child's 9-digit OEN student number, located beside their name on their report card, as well as their birthdate. For those who may not be aware of their child's OEN student number, contact your school to get the information

On inclement weather days, schools are very busy and rather than calling the school to see if a bus route is cancelled, you should visit the STSCO website or listen to your favourite, local radio station.

In keeping the above information in mind, everyone will be better prepared to deal with winter.

Inclement Weather Days

Wondering if your child's or teen's school bus is running during bad weather?

- √ Visit the Student Transportation Services of Ontario website at <u>www.stsco.ca</u> and click on "Cancellations & Delays" at the top of the homepage.
- Listen to your favourite local radio station for bus cancellation.
- √ Voluntarily provided email address for direct email notices from STSCO by logging into the "Parent Login", at www.stsco.ca, with your child's OEN and Birthdate
- Fill out this handy reminder:

✓ Please remember:

- Schools normally stay open even when buses are cancelled.
- If buses are cancelled in the morning, they won't run in the afternoon either.
- If your child rides a school bus and it's cancelled, you don't need to call the school to report the absence.
- If your child does not ride a school bus, you still need to call the school if he or she is absent, even on an inclement weather day.
- Please don't call the school to check on buses, as it ties up phone lines needed for possible emergency calls.
