If you have a child, or know of any-

one that has a child who is eligible to attend either Junior or Senior Kindergarten for September 2020, please come into the school or contact us at 705-745-0722 to register. In addition, you can register online at www.kprschools.ca.

The following information will assist you with the registration process: Junior Kindergarten students must be 4 as of December 31, 2020. Senior Kindergarten students must be 5 as of December 31, 2020. Proof of age by birth certificate or equivalent, proof of address and immunization must be provided. Accurate enrollment projections are key to acquiring funding from the Ministry of Education and to the Board's budget process.


# **School Council Update**

### **Step 1: Register**

a) If you have not registered, please go to the *School Cash Online* home page https://kprdsb.schoolcashonline.com/ and select the *"Get Started Today"* option.

b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps

\*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.



## **Step 2: Confirmation Email**

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account. The confirmation link will open the *School Cash Online* site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

## **Step 3: Find Student**

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name.
- b) Enter the School Name.
- c) Enter Your Child's First Name, Last Name and Birth Date.
- d) Select Continue.
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in

the Agree box and select Continue.

f) Your child has been added to your account.

## **Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student**

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" and repeat the steps above. 8 children can be added to one parent account. If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.
